

Kelley Fox Wines Durant Vineyard Pinot Noir 2022

I'm excited to offer you my first bottling of Durant Vineyard Pinot Noir! This is old vine, selfrooted Pommard planted in 1974 and 1984. Historical Dundee Hills fruit with all of the inimitable character that comes with it.

The Durant 2022 is medium-dark, youthful, rich ruby-red with beautiful light and transparency. It has the classic Dundee Hills nose of perfectly sun-ripe Oregon strawberries and subtle spices along with soft minerals. The mouth is the same, with a delicious sappiness and luxe texture without the heaviness. The structure is there in a way that is more pixelated than linear at the time of this tasting. Long finish. The Durant has the energy of full spring just into early summer: full of life. There should be a tarot card with a picture of this late spring queen all surrounded by Oregon strawberries and bluebird skies with puffy clouds and the feeling of building abundance.
